

'Belle Epoque' Recipe

You will need:

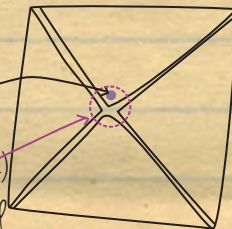
- OUR BELLE EPOQUE BLANK LASER CUT CARD (LC04)
- 141MM CARDSTOCK (YOUR CHOSEN STOCK WILL END IN C-3; WE RECOMMEND SILKWEAVE IVORY (SW1-C-3))
- SMALL CIRCLES OF CARD (HAND CUT/OFF CUTS ARE FINE!)
- EMBELLISHMENT (WE CHOSE OUR YORK DEYO-47)
- GLUES - GEM-TAC OR HOT MELT GLUE & ATG OR DOUBLE SIDED TAPE
- WE RECOMMEND OUR IVORY ENVELOPES ENV02-28

This design is really easy to make as our beautiful 'Belle Epoque' does all the hard work for you!

1. Print your invitation information onto the textured side of the 141mm Silkweave Ivory Cardstock (or a suitable alternative). The typesetting can be simple and you can add additional elements if you wish.
2. Run a suitable adhesive (ATG tape or double sided tape) to the back of the printed card and carefully attach your printed invitation into the middle section of the Belle Epoque card.
3. Draw around your embellishment on your small circles/off cuts of card and then cut out the shape (a few mm inside the line you've drawn). Glue your embellishment onto your shape using hot melt glue or Gem Tac. Leave to dry if necessary.
4. Take your embellishment and attach to the tip of triangle (of the Belle Epoque) that comes down from the top....

Put the glue on the triangle tip here

Place the embellishment (on it's card back) over the glue but in the centre of the card



Choosing an embellishment around 2.5cm in size is ideal as the weight of the embellishment holds the 'points' all together. How easy is that?
